The information contained on these pages is based on the baptismal, marriage & burial records for Neuwarp & Altharp, found on LDS films 18490 & 184907 with a little additional help from books about the pastors of Pomerania & Mecklenburg Schwerin.

## LAW AND ORDER IN NEUWARP

A search of some Burger lists yielded helpful information. (Film 1344656). There are no such lists for Neuwarp but for two nearby Mecklenburg towns, Waren & Malchow, some council records have survived. On beautifully written pages, under headings such as Personale Magistralas, (Council Members) & Consul Poies (?), there are lists of Burgermeisters, Senators Assessor Judicii, & Senators Cammerarii. Whether or not these were official paid positions or elected posts has not yet been discovered. The list below may be incomplete, but almost all those listed became part of the extended family, or were baptismal sponsors of the children.

Burgermeister - the Mayor, responsible for the organization of the town. Appointments were usually for a term of ten years, but as there were mostly two of them at a time, the ten year term may have applied to the senior office holder. In the Neuwarp church registers Caspar does not appear to have had a council position before becoming a Burgermeister, in fact he does not seem to have had any job at all, but judging by his children's baptismal sponsors, he must have had some council connections by the time he was married. One enquiry in the 1980s yielded the information that Caspar was an Inspector. See his successor & son-in-law, Matthais Krüger's job description.

Senator Assessor Judicii - the town police or magistrates? The men described as Consul & Judex belonged here. Their Oath of Office required them to uphold the law of the land, without fear or favour to any citizen

Senator Cammerarii - the town treasurers. - Those described simply as Senators supported their colleagues.

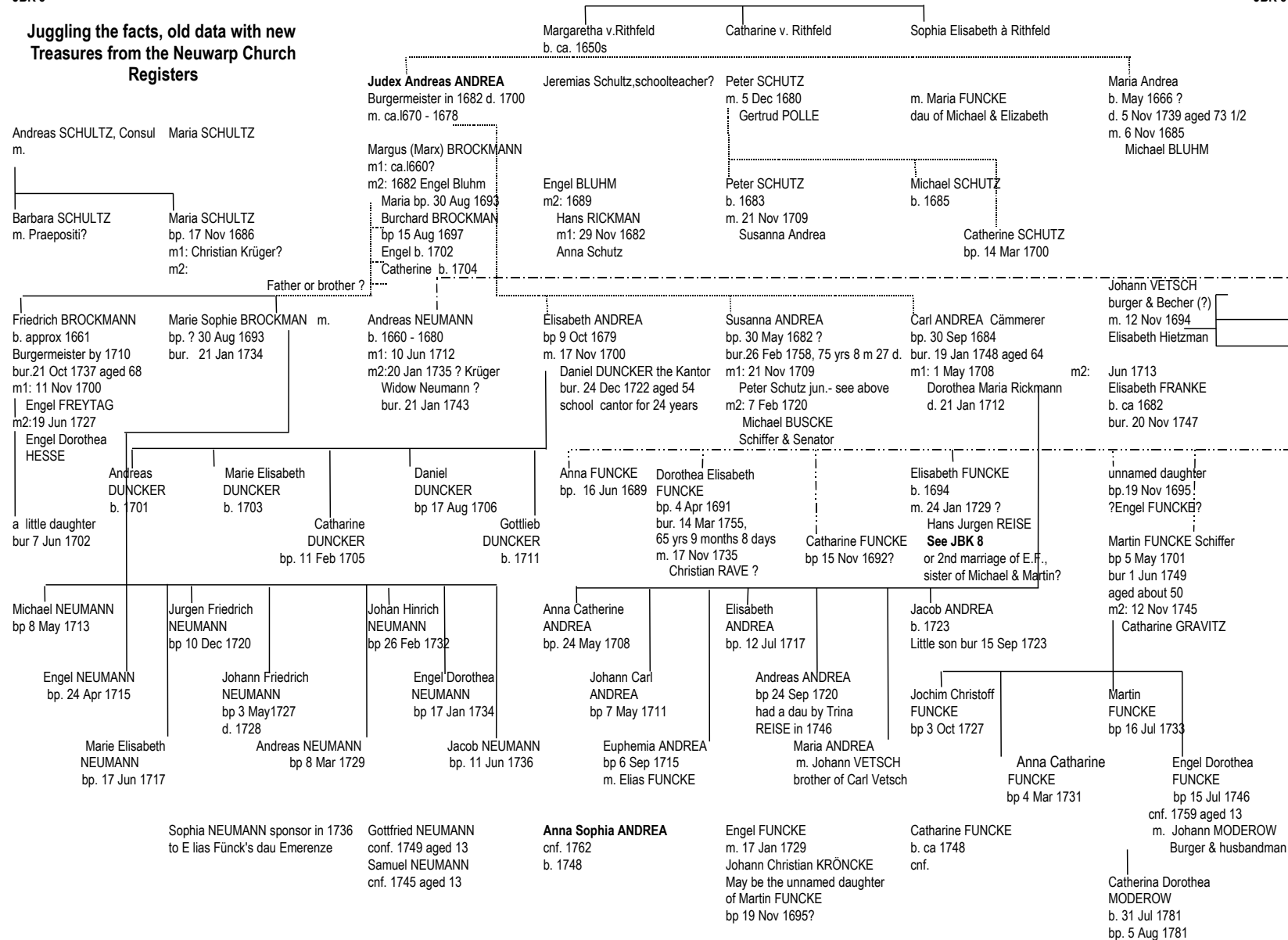

**Juggling the facts, old data with new Treasures from the Neuwarp Church Registers**



Is there enough evidence to claim Balthasar as father of Elisabeth & Caspar? There is Corny's booklet. We can assume that the family moved to Neuwarp either just before Elisabeth's marriage in 1695, or as a result of that marriage. Parents who survived long enough to retire would have been dependent on their children & would have lived with them as an extended family. Except for Martin Koloff & hisdaughters there are no other Kohlhoff families in Neuwarp, so Kohlhoff senior must surely refer to Caspar's father.???

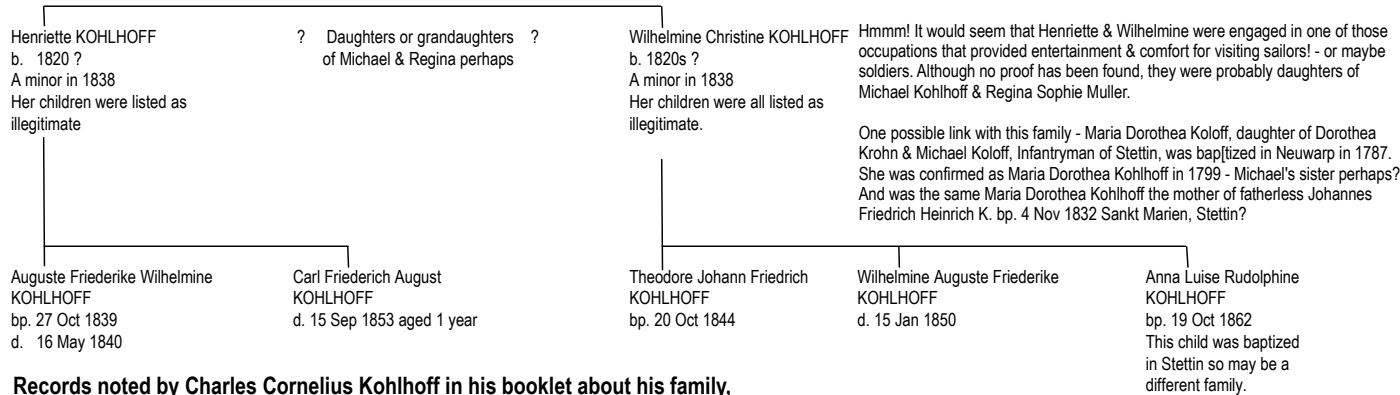

This family could be descended from one of Johann Balthasar Kohlhoff's brothers - Caspar or perhaps Carl Freiderich, though the latter may have died before Johann Balthasar left Europe since he is not mentioned in the farewell letter. (Pastoral Symphony page 46). It is possible that this Michael was a grandson of Cousin Michael.

Michael is described as a labourer which doesn't fit the family pattern of Councillors & Seamen. There are no additional clues in the Neuwarp registers that might confirm the births of Regina & Michael



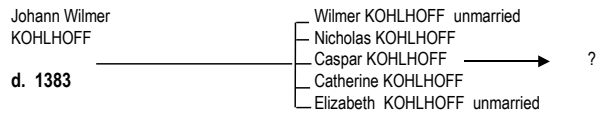
**Records noted by Charles Cornelius Kohlhoff in his booklet about his family, written 1893 - 1894, with some historical background**

Recorded history of Pomerania begins in the 10th century when the Slavic people there were conquered by a Polish ruler. They then enjoyed independence in the 11th century, but the Poles regained control in the 12th & introduced Christianity. At this time the country was split into two principalities. The eastern part became known as Pomerania, Further or Hinter Pomerania. It was annexed to Poland in 1294 but taken by the Teutonic Knights in 1308. The Knights incorporated it into their territory of East Prussia. Corny Kohlhoff, in his little booklet, suggests that Johann Melchior Kohlhoff came from Prussia. Could JMK have been living in Schlawe or Stolp where Kohlhoff families lived for at least two centuries, perhaps much longer? But Pomerania was returned to Poland in 1466 & remained part of that nation until 1772 when it again became part of Prussia.

Through all these changes Pomerania continued as a duchy of the Holy Roman Empire until 1637 when it was granted to the Elector of Brandenburg. In 1648, at the close of the Thirty Years War, or Religious Wars, the Treaty of Westphalia gave the western part, Hither Pomerania or Vor Pommern, with Stettin, Stralsund & the island of Rugen, to Sweden.

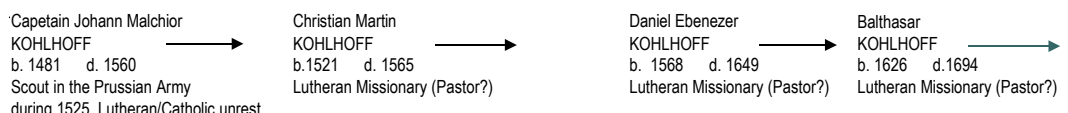
In 1720, as a result of the Northern War, Sweden lost half of its portion of Vor Pommern, including Stettin, to Prussia. Neuwarp remained in Swedish hands, along with larger neighbours such as Stralsund & Griefswald, until 1815.

Although control of the land had changed so often, Pomerania had become thoroughly Germanized. German settlers were being sent to populate the area as early as the 12th & 13th centuries & their language soon became the language of Pomerania. One strand of Kohlhoff folklore suggests that the family originated in Hannover. Were there perhaps some Kohlhoffs among these original German settlers?

All the families listed here lived within a small area of Western Pomerania & Mecklenburg Strelitz, with just one little family found in Strasburg, Uckermarke. There must have been a common link, just two or three generations earlier perhaps? Could Johann Melchior Kollhoff be that link?

from about 1607-1629. Born about 1570-1580

Balthasar Kollhoff died Neuwarp, 1700 Born about 1635 - possibly worked in Strasburg & Rostock
