Charles Mead lost his parents early & was educated under the guidance of his uncle Rev John Hunt, but lived mostly with his maternal aunt in London. Although Charles was educated to take orders in the Established Church, the Church of England, he became involved with the early Methodists instead. He was ordained at Chichester 6 March 1816, married his cousin Ann Hunt in Islington soon after his ordination & left for India almost immediately.
